Why should you book this trip?

- The Centre for Art and Culture SURIYAKANTHA is an unforgettable landmark at the heart of Sri Lanka's cultural capital, Kandy.
- The house of a Village Chief has been transformed into a functional art centre with all the facilities needed while keeping intact its Dutch-style architecture dating back to the 18th century.
- Its collection reflects the interests of its founders Rohan de Silva and Jacques Soulier – traditional furniture, art items, antique books, photographs, and postcards covering two cultures – Sri Lankan and French.
- Professor Jacques Soulier speaks English and French and will take you through the arts and culture gallery with in-depth explanations over lunch.
- Suriyakantha is located 10km from Kandy city centre, on the road leading to religious and historical sites of the Gampola Period (14th Century AD). We will take you to these spectacular locations as well.

- The center has Pali, Sinhala, English and French documentation and resources for research work on Sri Lankan history, specifically the Kandyan period (18th Century).
- Suriyakantha contributes to the recognition of Sri Lankan contemporary art, particularly photography. The centre plans to display its collection of historical printings while celebrating new talents with dedicated temporary exhibitions and publishing.

Professor Jacques Soulier

Professor Jacques Soulier, born in Toulouse, France, is the Director of the Alliance Française (French Cultural Centre) in Kandy. Soulier is a psychiatrist by profession and has been based in Sri Lanka for several years. He is considered to be one of the great contributors to Franco-Sri Lankan relations as he has served several years teaching the French language in his adopted country. He has also worked at the University of Peradeniya, as a visiting French language lecturer.

Although he is French, Soulier speaks and understands the Sinhalese language. He has been the catalyst for several arts and literary events in the Kandy area over the years.

You will be free to wander around the house and garden to witness its Dutch-style colonial architecture and its beautiful surroundings. After pampering the elephants, you will say goodbye to your new-found friends – your own personal elephant and mahout – and you will be directed to have your traditional Sri Lankan lunch in a village house.
