Tour in brief

- After a short briefing of the tour and on safety, you will be taken on a Tuk Tuk to the floating dock on the lagoon. Hop on your canoe (seats 2 or 3 people max) and your guide will lead you around the lagoon.
- Explore the hidden area and view the surrounding formidable mangrove forest.
- Varieties of flora and fauna dependent on this delicate coastal ecosystem will be seen.
- Refreshments will be provided during the canoe trip.
- Total paddling time is approximately 2 hours, but it can vary depending on your group and on the weather. We are flexible to your plans.
