Why should you book this trip?

- The convenient distance from the international airport (15 km) makes it easy to add a dive trip in Negombo at the beginning or end of your holiday in Sri Lanka.
- Equally good as a “thing to do in Negombo” and as an activity to do during a long beach stay in Negombo.
- The hidden world in Negombo has remained relatively unspoiled even with the throngs of tourists that visit every year.

- Visitors get the chance to dive into these waters to witness the colourful and exotic life that thrives beneath the surface. Vibrant corals, schools of multi-coloured fish and interesting shipwrecks are aplenty in this underwater paradise.
- Excellent marine life: Schools of barracuda, travelly, fusiliers, blue stripe snappers, honey comb moray, large schools of goldline, spinetrek, Oriental sweet lips, Yellow jack, lobsters, and rays are some of the fishes that could be seen.
- Excellent shipwrecks: Wreck Chief Dragon, Taprobane wreck, and Aircraft carrier wreck of 1945 are some of the best.
- You will be led by an experienced and knowledgeable diver master.

Quick Facts

- Availability – November to April experience and see are different during these 2 seasons
- Duration: 3-4 Hours
- Transfer arrangements to be picked up and dropped off to any preferred destination could be provided on request
- Meeting point – Could be mutually agreed upon or you may directly come to the dive station
- Best possible times – Early morning hours 9 a.m.
- Possible to extend the activity with accommodation and other activities like fishing

- You will be met by the excursion leader at this point. After the documentation, safety briefing and equipment check, we will be heading to your preferred dive sites.

- Due to the monsoon seasons, the best time to go diving in Negombo is between November and April. With several intriguing diving sites available, you can even choose to enjoy wreck diving.
- Negombo dive sites are categorised to rims based on the distance from the show.
