- You will have the chance to see the art of framing pottery in the traditional way and how these artisans adapt their craft to suit more modern expectations and styles.
- During this engaging tour, the villagers will serve you a cup of tea or a herbal drink - a means of gaining an insightful experience of rural lifestyle and hospitality.
- This responsible trail will immerse you in a traditional industry; a home-grown livelihood that deserves merit and recognition.
- After the tour, you will cycle back to the starting point where a traditional local lunch will be served, which you will enjoy in a hut - made from mud!
